Points of sale for rubbish (garbage) sacks and stickers

- ◆ Metzgerei Fuchs (butchers)
- ◆ COOP Mürren (only stickers and sacks)
- ◆ Einwohnerkontrolle (Local Authority) Lauterbrunnen

We request apartment owners to inform their guests about the correct disposal of waste and if necessary to provide the appropriate rubbish bags or stickers. Property owners are responsible for their guests, who fail to dispose of waste correctly even if they have already departed.

Collection days:

Household rubbish (payable)

Collection begins at 8.30 am

From 01.01.2012 – 30.04.2012

Monday and Friday

From 31.05.2012 – 31.10.2012

Monday and Friday

From 06.12.2012 – 31.12.2012

Monday and Friday

At other times only on Mondays (May and November)

Extra collection for hotels on Wednesdays

01.01.2012 – 20.04.2012 and 13.12.2012 – 31.12.2012

If the collection day falls on a public holiday, the collection will take place on the next work day.

Rubbish sacks must not be put out before the collection days

Bulky items (payable)

Dimensions of bulky items per sticker

50 x 50 x 50 cm

maximum 18 kg

For larger or heavier items, please attach the appropriate number of stickers.

Boilers may either be returned to the installer or require **10 bulky items stickers** for collection. **Alternatively:** deliver directly to AVAG, loading station, Geissgasse, 3800 Interlaken.

Scrap metal

Scrap metal can be disposed of free of charge. Dates same as for bulky items. Please put the scrap metal separate to other rubbish.

Classed as bulky items and not scrap metal:

Ovens, skis, car wheels, motorbikes, mopeds, garden chairs with plastic, parasols, bath tubs, shower trays, chrome work surfaces, wheelbarrows, bob-style sledges, boilers, industrial kitchen appliances, concrete blocks.

Attention:

An advance payment for recycling (vRG) is payable when purchasing electric storage heaters, oil radiators, ironing machines, petrol lawn mowers, barbecues (apart from charcoal barbecues) and these must be disposed of via the SENS recycling system and not in the bulky items collection.

Further Infos

Domestic rubbish (excluding builder's rubble and rubbish and bulky items) will be collected in the normal rubbish collection.

Glass Please deposit only glass bottles in the blue glass container at the Schilthorn cable car station, at the old school house and Aegerten.




No bottle tops – no window panes – no drinking glasses - no ceramic

Paper and cardboard Paper and cardboard should be flattened and tied up in bundles and put out ready on the collection days.

The following are not accepted: filled boxes, coated wrapping paper, paper for flowers, labels, filter paper, photo envelopes, household paper, stickers, carbon paper, serviettes, table cloths, nappies (diapers), feedstuff bags, milk and fruit juice packaging, washing powder containers and cement bags.

Bulky items Large non-metal objects such as wood, mattresses, plastics, garden chairs and similar may be put out ready, with bulky items stickers attached, at the usual collection points (as rubbish) on the collection days. The maximum of 2m³ requires 16 bulky items stickers.

Electric devices:

<p>Office equipment, telecommunications and computer equipment, home entertainment systems. Recycling is paid for by a prepaid (on purchase) disposal fee. Electric waste does not belong in the normal rubbish and should be returned to a dealer or returns point for correct disposal. The organisation of the disposal is regulated for the whole of Switzerland. Electric waste may be returned to the firm Leuenberger in Wilderswil, free of charge.

The collection point (free of charge) for office, telecommunications and computer equipment and home entertainment systems is at the BLM station, Mürren.

Which devices do not have prepaid recycling fees (vRG): all devices which are not on the SENS-list (available from the building department of the local authority). The most important of these are: refrigerated cabinets, compressors which measure more than 4,20m in total, household installations which were originally bricked in (boilers, oil heating etc.), light bulbs, neon signs, spectral lights, lasers.

Oil Small quantities of oil from private households may be handed in to the local authority depot at Aegerten.

Batteries Vehicle batteries should be returned to a dealer or to Stäger Transport AG, Mürren. Other batteries, eg. torch batteries should be returned to the place of purchase.

Building rubble / building waste The disposal of building rubble and rubbish, house contents and commercial scrap metal waste is the responsibility of the property owner or building firm.

Tins Please put tin and aluminium cans in the red container by the old school house.

Chemicals	Solvents, acids, mercury from thermometers, paints, varnish, medication etc. may be returned to the place of purchase.
Discharge lamps	So-called discharge lamps like fluorescent, energy saving or halogen lamps (not light bulbs) can be returned to the EW.
Pet bottles	Please return to the place of purchase.
Textiles	Collection points in Lauterbrunnen at the old school house and in Stechelberg at the school house.

Please do not put out **hot** ashes for collection.

Burning waste outdoors

The burning of waste from tree cutting in the forest or less than 30m from the edge of the forest is strictly forbidden! Included in this ban are all materials resulting from wood cutting or tending of the forest, for example, branches, cuttings, bark, foliage, sawdust.

The correct way:

Branches and wood waste can be left strewn to decay naturally. Waste from tree cutting may also be gathered together in loose piles of branches. An information leaflet can be downloaded from www.http://be.ch/wald.

Damp plant waste fires:

According to the stipulations of the Swiss regulations regarding air pollution (LRV) burning damp plant waste is strictly illegal. I.e. foliage, fresh branches or damp or wet plant waste may not be burnt outdoors. Dry, natural forest, field or garden waste may be burnt outdoors if only very little smoke is produced.

Barbeque fires and camp fires are allowed. However all required measures must be taken to avoid fire damage.

Commercial containers

Commercial containers must have a payable seal attached. Commercial containers must be filled in such a way that the lid can still be closed. The seal must be stuck on the front of the container from the lid to the container. If this is not the case, there are two possibilities:

1. The surplus sacks will not be collected by the transporter.
2. The producer of the rubbish may attach additional stickers to the surplus sacks.
