Depositing paper, cardboard, scrap metal and bulky items at the entrance to the loading station below the railway station is forbidden!

We request apartment owners to inform their guests about the correct disposal of waste and if necessary to provide the appropriate rubbish bags or stickers. Property owners are responsible for their guests, who fail to dispose of waste correctly even if they have already departed.

Classed as bulky items and not scrap metal:

Ovens, skis, car wheels, motorbikes, mopeds, garden chairs with plastic, parasols, bath tubs, shower trays, chrome work surfaces, wheelbarrows, bob-style sledges, boilers, industrial kitchen appliances, concrete blocks.

Attention:

An advance payment for recycling (vRG) is payable when purchasing electric storage heaters, oil radiators, ironing machines, petrol lawn mowers, barbecues (apart from charcoal barbecues) and these must be disposed of via the SENS recycling system and not in the bulky items collection. Payment for garden waste collection as for bulky goods.

Please put out ready at the collection points. Bundles should not be bigger than 60 litres! On the above mentioned collection days between 9-11am, you may transport small quantities of greenery yourself to the disposal site and these will be disposed of free of charge. On request you may dispose of greenery yourself before 14th May. Please contact Hans Kobel, council worker, for information Tel. 033 855 19 16 or 079 422 94 83. Branch cuttings are payable per m³.

Please compost as much as possible yourself!

Further Infos

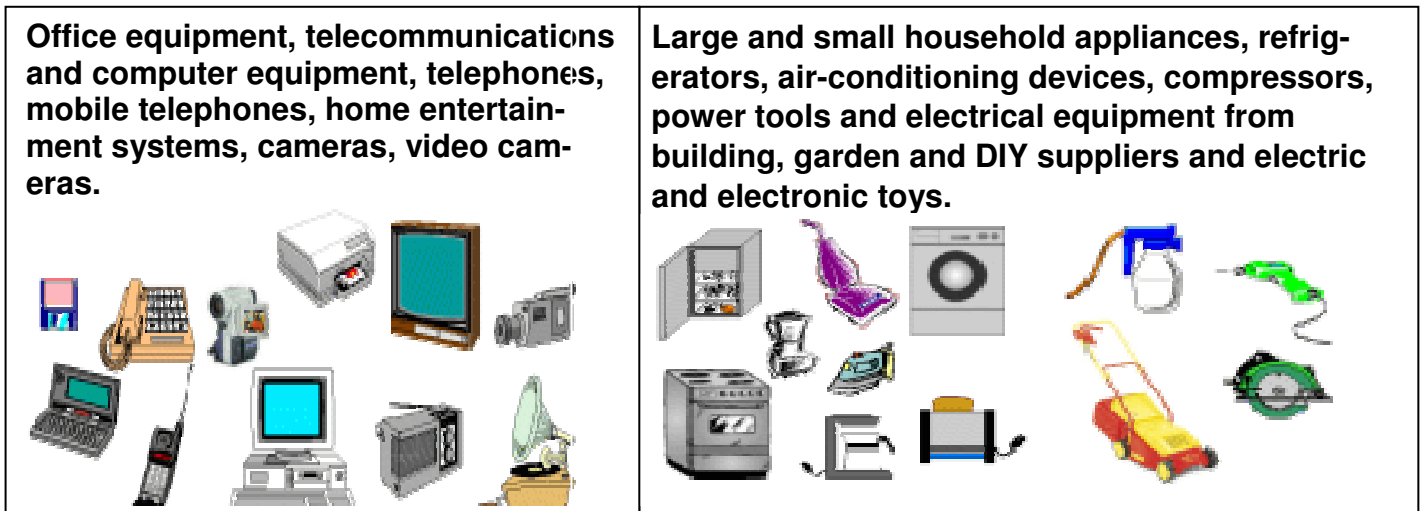
Domestic rubbish (excluding builder's rubble and rubbish and bulky items) will be collected in the normal rubbish collection

Glass Please deposit glass bottles without tops and separated by colour in the special containers. Location: railway station, Am Acher, Schiltwald, Ledi, Wengwald.

No ceramic – no bottle tops – no window panes – no drinking glasses

Bulky items Large non-metal objects such as wood, mattresses, plastics, garden chairs and similar may be put out ready, with bulky items stickers attached, at the usual collection points (as rubbish) on the collection days. The maximum of 2m³ requires 16 bulky items stickers.
 Per sticker bulky items must not exceed the dimensions 50 cm x 50 cm x 50 cm and weight 18 kg. Larger items require more bulky items stickers accordingly.
 Industrial and commercial waste and building waste is not classed as bulky items.

Electric devices:



Please hand in on the first Thursday of every month at the regional centre railway station WAB.

The recycling is paid for by an advance payment for disposal (**vRG**) on purchase. If the devices are to be collected with the bulky items collection, **bulky items stickers must be attached.**

Which devices do not have prepaid recycling fees (vRG): all devices which are not on the SENS-list (available from the building department of the local authority). The most important of these are: refrigerated cabinets, compressors which measure more than 4,20m in total, household installations which were originally bricked in (boilers, oil heating etc.), light bulbs, neon signs, spectral lights, lasers.

Paper and cardboard Paper and cardboard should be flattened and tied up in bundles and put out **cardboard** ready on the collection days

The following are not accepted: coated wrapping paper, paper for flowers, labels, filter paper, photo envelopes, household paper, stickers, carbon paper, serviettes, table cloths, nappies (diapers), feedstuff bags, milk and fruit juice packaging, washing powder containers and cement bags.

Pet-bottles Please return to the place of purchase.

Tins Please wash thoroughly, remove top and bottom and dispose of in the red containers.

Locations: Am Acher, Schiltwald, Wengwald, Bahnhof, Galliweidli, Sengg, Bellevue.
Hotels should use the collection skip at the railway station.

Batteries	Car batteries must be returned to a dealer or the firm Leuenberger, Wilderswil. Other batteries, e.g. torch batteries, can be returned to the place of purchase.
Medication	Please return to the place of purchase.
Oil	Only small quantities of oil (maximum 10 litres) from private households will be disposed of. Please empty the oil into the appropriate container at the railway station. There are special regulations for hotels.
Colours and chemicals	Solvents, acids, mercury from thermometers, paints, varnish, medication etc. may be returned to the place of purchase.
Clothes and textiles	Texaid' collection container at the railway station; For information: Tel. 033 855 27 87. The special collection sacks are available the whole year at the following shops: Coiffeur Bischoff, pharmacy, Chäs Gruebi, Tourist office.
Building rubble / Building rubbish	The disposal of building rubble and rubbish and commercial scrap metal waste is the responsibility of the property owner or building firm.

Burning waste outdoors

The burning of waste from tree cutting in the forest or less than 30m from the edge of the forest is strictly forbidden! Included in this ban are all materials resulting from wood cutting or tending of the forest, for example, branches, cuttings, bark, foliage, sawdust.

The correct way:

Branches and wood waste can be left strewn to decay naturally. Waste from tree cutting may also be gathered together in loose piles of branches. An information leaflet can be downloaded from [www.http://be.ch/wald](http://be.ch/wald).

Damp plant waste fires:

According to the stipulations of the Swiss regulations regarding air pollution (LRV) burning damp plant waste is strictly illegal. I.e. foliage, fresh branches or damp or wet plant waste may not be burnt outdoors. Dry, natural forest, field or garden waste may be burnt outdoors if only very little smoke is produced.

Barbeque fires and camp fires are allowed. However all required measures must be taken to avoid fire damage.

Commercial containers

Commercial containers must have a payable seal attached. Commercial containers must be filled in such a way that the lid can still be closed. The seal must be stuck on the front of the container from the lid to the container. If this is not the case, there are two possibilities:

1. The surplus sacks will not be collected by the transporter.
2. The producer of the rubbish may attach additional stickers to the surplus sacks.
